Bring your e-waste to Butler's campus for a community drive-through collection event in partnership with Technology Recyclers. We'll unload your car and sort your electronics for recycling to protect our groundwater, soil, campus, and community from hazardous materials.

Examples of Accepted Items:

- » CRT monitors
- » Tube TVs
- » LCD displays
- » Computers
- » Printers
- » Laptops
- » Fax machines
- » Office copiers
- » Christmas lights
- » Industrial electronics
- » Consumer electronics including DVD players, stereos, radios, calculators
- » Speakers
- » Cell phones
- » VCRs
- » Television production equipment
- » Cables
- » IT equipment including hubs, switches, servers, routers, racks etc.
- » Medical electronics
- » Satellite TV equipment
- » Printed circuit boards
- » Microwave ovens
- » Lead acid batteries
- » Electrical equipment
- » Laboratory equipment
- » Most small appliances and items that have cords and plug in (no large, full size appliances accepted)
- » Other loose batteries (we do take the batteries within the electronics)

All TVs and monitors have a \$20.00 fee each.

Copy machines and devices containing Freon are \$30, which will be collected before the item will be taken.

Full size appliances, paper documents, paint, toxic chemicals, furniture, wood, tires, and clothing **WILL NOT** be accepted.

Butler employees and students get a \$10 discount on paid items. Cash or check preferred.
