The APP will work closely and collaboratively with attending surgeons and general surgery residents, participating in daily rounds, assisting with bedside procedures, and contributing to the surgical management of acutely ill patients. Autonomy in patient care and strong interdisciplinary collaboration are central to this role. APPs are also required to complete a First Assist course which is fully reimbursed by the institution. This is an excellent opportunity for providers seeking to develop or expand their acute surgical expertise in a fast-paced, educationally rich environment. APPs are actively involved in education, quality improvement, and research initiatives, contributing to the advancement of surgical care. ### Key Responsibilities:

- Provide comprehensive care for emergency general surgery patients from initial consultation to discharge and follow-up.
- Collaborate closely with surgical residents and attending surgeons during daily rounds and care planning.
- Perform patient assessments, develop and implement treatment plans, order and interpret diagnostics, and manage inpatient care.

- Perform surgical consultations, assist with bedside procedures, and provide timely documentation and communication across disciplines.

- First assist in surgical procedures after completing fully reimbursed First Assist course.
- Participate in outpatient surgery clinics for post-operative care and ongoing surgical follow-up.
