- *Music students who receive a JCA Talent Award must take Applied Lessons (AM) at the major level and must participate in a major ensemble every semester they are on campus.
- At least 40 credits must be at the 300-level or higher.
- A grade of C or higher is required for all JCA courses.
- Arts Administration majors fulfill the following requirements of the University Core Curriculum: The Social World (because they take 9 hours in the social sciences), Perspectives in the Creative Arts (because they take 9 hours in the arts), the Indianapolis Community Requirement, and the Butler Cultural Requirement.
- Arts Administration-Music majors may choose to complete one or more areas of Emphasis (Music Composition, Jazz Studies, Music History, Music Performance [Instrumental, Piano. or Vocal], Music Theory, Piano Pedagogy), which will be noted on the transcript.
- For students considering a career as a professional musician and/or graduate studies in music, adding the BA in Music as a secondary major (17 additional music credits) is recommended.
- All Arts Administration majors are required to attend Arts Events; requirements are available online. Arts Administration majors who add a secondary major in music are required to follow the School of Music arts event attendance requirements for three years, and the Arts Administration requirements for one year. See the School of Music website for distribution requirements for music majors.
