- The double major of Art + Design and International Studies will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts and The Social World. In addition, the B.A. Art + Design curriculum fulfills the Indianapolis Community Requirement of the Butler University Core Curriculum; art majors fulfill the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors.
- The International Studies major requires 42 credit hours; 33 must be at the 300-level or higher. Study Abroad is highly recommended, as is participation in the Model United Nations, the Model Arab League, and/or the Model European Union. The cost for participating in these events (registration, airfare, lodging) is covered by the International Studies budget.
- The student will be assigned an International Studies advisor in addition to their Art advisor.
