In addition, the B.A. Theatre curriculum fulfills both the Indianapolis Community Requirement and the Butler Cultural Requirement.
- The GRE (Graduate Record Exam) is usually required for Physical Therapy schools.
- The student will be assigned a Pre-Health advisor in addition to their Theatre advisor.
