

B.A. IN MUSIC PLUS PRE-PHYSICAL THERAPY

- The B.A. degree in Music requires 120 credits.
 - --66 hours must be non-music credits.
 - --40 hours must be 300 or 400-level courses.
 - --All music majors have Arts Event Attendance Requirements; for details, check https://www.butler.edu/jca/for-current-students.
- The combination of Music and Pre-Physical Therapy will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts, The Social World, The Natural World, and Analytic Reasoning. In addition, the B.A. Music curriculum fulfills the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors. The Indianapolis Community Requirement is NOT satisfied.
- The GRE (Graduate Record Exam) is usually required for Physical Therapy schools.
- The student will be assigned a Pre-Health advisor in addition to their Music advisor.
