

B.A. IN MUSIC PLUS A SECONDARY MAJOR IN ENGLISH

- The B.A. degree in Music requires 120 credits.
 - --66 hours must be non-music credits.
 - --40 hours must be 300 or 400-level courses.
 - --All music majors have Arts Event Attendance Requirements; for details, check https://www.butler.edu/jca/for-current-students.
- The English major has four tracks: Literature; Creative Writing; Literary Theory, Culture, and Criticism; and Professional Writing. The eight-semester plan below is for the Literature track; the additional courses needed to complete the other tracks are listed in the Summary.
- The double major of Music and English will fulfill the following Areas of Inquiry in the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives of the Creative Arts and Texts and Ideas. In addition, the B.A. Music curriculum fulfills the Butler Cultural Requirement because of the arts event attendance requirements for all arts majors. The Indianapolis Community Requirement is NOT satisfied.
- The student will be assigned an English advisor in addition to their Music advisor.
