- At least 40 credits must be at the 300-level or higher.
- A grade of C or higher is required for all ART courses.
- Art majors fulfill the following requirements of the University Core Curriculum: Perspectives in the Creative Arts (because they take nine credit hours in the arts), the Indianapolis Community Requirement, and the Butler Cultural Requirement.
- The BA degree in Art Education fulfills The Social World requirement of the University Core Curriculum because students take 9 credit hours in the social sciences.
- All Art majors are required to attend Arts Events; requirements are available online.

TESTING REQUIREMENTS

Both pedagogy and content tests (also known as PRAXIS exams) are required for teaching licensure in the state of Indiana.

Candidates should request that scores be sent to BOTH Butler and the Indiana Department of Education.

PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENT

PPAT (Praxis Performance Assessment for Teachers) is required to be submitted to ETS for national scoring during Phase I of Student Teaching by all licensure areas.

CPR/HEIMLICH/AED and SUICIDE AWARENESS/PREVENTION

Applicants who receive an 'initial' teacher's license must have successfully completed training in:

1. cardiopulmonary resuscitation that includes a test demonstration on a mannequin.
2. removing a foreign body causing an obstruction in an airway, and the Heimlich Maneuver.
3. AED.
4. suicide awareness/prevention (minimum of one hour).

A copy of your CPR/Heimlich/AED certification is required for original licensure. A certificate verifying your successful completion of a suicide awareness/prevention module is required for original licensure.
