- All Art majors are required to attend Arts Events; requirements are available online.

## **TESTING REQUIREMENTS**

Both pedagogy and content tests (also known as PRAXIS exams) are required for teaching licensure in the state of Indiana.

### **PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENT**

PPAT (Praxis Performance Assessment for Teachers) is required to be submitted to ETS for national scoring during Phase I of Student Teaching by all licensure areas.

### **CPR/HEIMLICH/AED and SUICIDE AWARENESS/PREVENTION**

Applicants who receive an 'initial' teacher's license must have successfully completed training in:

1. cardiopulmonary resuscitation that includes a test demonstration on a mannequin.
2. removing a foreign body causing an obstruction in an airway, and the Heimlich Maneuver.
3. AED.
4. suicide awareness/prevention (minimum of one hour).

**A copy of your CPR/Heimlich/AED certification is required for original licensure. A certificate verifying your successful completion of a suicide awareness/prevention module is required for original licensure.**
