

# PARK BUTLER

## PLAY *it* SAFE

### KNOW *the* REGULATIONS

- › **ALL STUDENT/STAFF/FACULTY VEHICLES REQUIRE A PERMIT.** This includes those here for a day or an academic year. Citations are issued for non-registration. This includes areas such as the Hinkle lot, parking garage and parking meters.
- › **NEIGHBORHOOD PARKING PROHIBITED.** Students, staff and faculty are prohibited from parking in the Butler Tarkington neighborhood, which surrounds the Butler Campus. They are required to park on campus controlled property with a permit or on private property with the owners permission.
- › **ENFORCEMENT.** Parking enforcement is in place 24/7 throughout the year, including when school is not in session. If an area allows different permits during a certain time of day or during certain parts of the year it will be written on the posted signage.
- › **VISITORS.** If you see the term “visitors” used for parking on campus it specifically excludes students, staff, and faculty from the definition. Parking for those groups is controlled by permit.
- › **METERED PARKING.** Metered parking is available on campus. Students, staff and faculty are required to have a valid Butler permit to park at the meters on campus.
- › **LARGE EVENTS.** During many Clowes Hall events as well as football and men’s basketball campus will go into “event mode” and an event rate is charged to park on campus. The Hinkle lot must be cleared for event parking for Football and Men’s Basketball events.
- › **COMMUNICATION.** Check the Butler Today and the Butler App for news and information about parking restrictions that may come up.

## IMPORTANT TIPS *about*

### PARKING *on the* BUTLER CAMPUS

- › **PERMIT PLACEMENT AND EXPIRATION.** Attach your permit on the rear window in the lower left corner. If you already have a permit, you **MUST REMOVE IT** before applying the new permit. The expiration date is printed on the permit.
- › **NEED ASSISTANCE WITH YOUR VEHICLE?** Contact the Butler University Police Department for lock-out services and jump starts 24/7. Call the non-emergency number at 940-BUPD (2873) and press option #1.
- › **ADA PARKING.** State Issued ADA credentials are valid for parking in ADA spaces on campus. ADA credentials will allow the user to park in any lot designated A, B, or C if there are no available ADA spaces. Temporary ADA needs require a Butler ADA Hangtag. There is no cost for the hangtag, but permit requirements are still in place for students and employees. Anyone with a disability that needs assistance can contact University Police.
- › **SUNSET AVENUE PARKING GARAGE** Individuals with A, B, C, or T permits may park in the garage with their ID’s free of the daily rate. B permit-holders are restricted to the 6th floor of the parking garage for overnight parking. Other decals are not permitted to park overnight. Garage rates are posted at [www.butler.edu/parking/visitor-event-parking](http://www.butler.edu/parking/visitor-event-parking).
- › **OVERNIGHT GUESTS** will be permitted to park in the I lot or Haughey Ave at no cost if space is available. A hangtag from parking services or BUPD is required.
- › **ALL STUDENT RESIDENT PERMITS** (B, C, AV and T) allow you to park in the I lot in the event that parking isn’t available in other lots on campus.
- › **BTNA PERMIT.** If you live in the Butler Tarkington neighborhood, you may receive an “R” permit at no cost. This will allow you to park on the street in front of your residence. Please contact the Office of Parking Services at 317-940-9243 for more information. This permit is not valid on campus.
