1) Mandatory Immunizations - provide original vaccination records/history:

- a) Evidence of childhood primary series
- b) Tdap, routinely given between 11-12 years of age, must be within the past 10 years (1 dose)
- c) Hepatitis B, complete series (3 doses)
- d) Varicella (Chicken Pox) (2 doses)
 - i) Or a quantitative (numeric) blood titer history of disease is **not** sufficient
- e) MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) (2 doses)
 - i) Or quantitative (numeric) blood titers
- f) Meningitis, Meningococcal conjugate vaccine (Brand names: Menactra and Menveo)
 - i) One dose after the age of 16
- g) Meningitis, Serogroup B meningococcal vaccine (Brand names: Bexsero and Trumenba, 2 doses)
 - i) Record MUST specify which brand was given to ensure compliance they are not interchangeable

Recommended for all students:

- a) MMR booster attending a fully residential campus places your student at greater risk
- b) Hepatitis A
- c) HPV
- d) **Flu**, annually
- e) Covid-19 plus booster

TB evaluation required only for International students or students that are considered high risk by the CDC:

a) IGRA/Quantiferon Gold Plus Blood test within 6 months of attendance

2) Mandatory Online Questionnaires:

 - i) Health History Questionnaire
 - ii) Tuberculosis Screening
 - iii) TeleMedicine Consent

Failure to submit required documentation (Physical Examination, Immunizations and Insurance Verification) may result in a late charge of \$25 per submission.

- a) Failure to provide the documentation by the due date will result in a "hold" placed on the student's account. This prevents the student's ability to change, add, or drop any classes and register for future classes
