- **Over \$340K in scholarships awarded during academic year 25/26 to cadets**

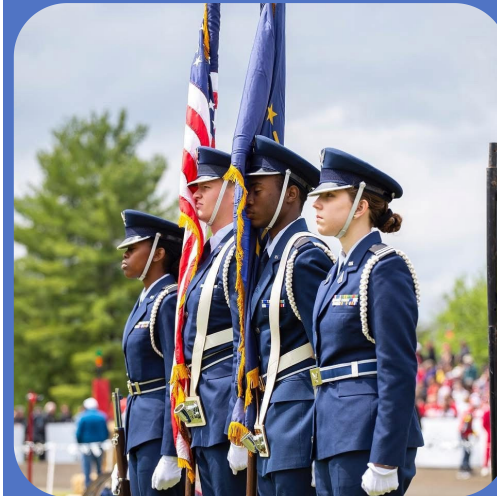
How to Join

Enroll through the Department of Aerospace Studies
Air Force ROTC is typically a 3, 3.5, or 4 year program
Freshmen will select

- AERO-A 101 & 151 in the Fall
- AERO-A 102 & 152 in the Spring

Sophomores will select

- AERO-A 101, 201, & 151 in the Fall
- AERO-A 102, 202, & 152 in the Spring



Cadets at Detachment 215 have the opportunity to commission into either the United States Air Force or Space Force upon graduating!



Requirements

To join, you must

- Be a U.S. citizen (or in a pursuing status*)
- Have a minimum 2.0 Term/Cumulative GPA
- Be a full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours)

Cadets will be required to

- Pass a Physical Fitness Assessment
- Meet medical standards
- Pass an Air Force Officer Qualification Test
- Maintain a GPA over 2.0

- Free IU football game tickets in the ROTC endzone section
- Guaranteed career upon graduating and commissioning!
